
Feedback analysis report (2018-2019)

Feedback from students about teachers Performance


Feedback from students about the teachers is collected and their performance is analyzed on the basis of their performance on time sense, subject command, use of teaching methods and their helping attitude towards students.

Teachers' Performance in Time Sense





Teachers' Performance on Subject Command





It has been found from the responses of the students that majority of them agree that the




Students found that teachers provide them study material which is not available in text

also help students to overcome the physical, emotional and learning challenges.


Feedback from students about college

Helping attitude of Library and non-teaching staff




 The students were satisfied with the internet facility provided in the College. They have good access of internet in the college library and UGC resource center.

Drinking Water, Cleanliness and Greenary in campus




The students found the college campus green and eco-friendly. Although, few of students

regular basis.




Feedback from Teachers' about Curriculum

The curriculum content is relevant to intended learners.





The physical facilities like class rooms, lab equipment and ICT are sufficient.




 Mostly teachers strongly agree with the fact that lab facilities and ICT are sufficient in the college but few of them still feel that these facilities should be developed more in the campus.

Adequate number of books, journals and elearning resources are available in library.




 Most of the faculty members are satisfied with the books and e-resources available in the library. But still every year new books editions are added in the library to keep resources updated.

Curriculum design is practical oriented and challenging.




 The faculty members found that curriculum is found in such a way that it is practically oriented but few of them do want more practical additions.

Curriculum is relevant to the regional/national developmental needs.




 Most of the faculty members do agree with that the designed curriculum satisfy the regional and national development needs.

Student's grievances regarding evaluation results are addressed.




 The students grievances regarding evaluation results are properly redreed. If any fault is found then proper representtaion is sent to university from the college authorities.

Effective feedback mechanism is utilized for updating course content.




 Most of the faculty members do agree with the fact that an effective mechanism is followed for updating the course content whenever is required.
